



Alphabet Letter Clay Art

Materials: White *Crayola Air Dry Clay*, (CADC) 1 pkg. per child, red, blue & yellow markers, (for coloring CADC) aluminum foil, embellishments: glitter, rhinestones, ribbon

Materials supplied by teacher: PLAY DOH, 1 x 12 inch dowel, tongue depressors, small wooden sticks, paper plates, photo reproductions of the alphabet, various alphabet books

What to do:

1. Pass out styrofoam plates.
2. Provide each child with sample ball of Play-doh. Encourage children to play with the clay before they begin to experiment forming the first letter of their names.
3. Collect Play Doh from children and pass out CADC.
4. Demonstrate how to use watercolor marker to mix color into CADC clay. Have children mix color thoroughly.
5. Use dowels to roll CADC flat. Make sure not to roll to thin.
6. Use fingers to roll/form letter shape
7. Place letter shape on surface of styrofoam plate.
6. Gently push embellishments into surface of CADC letter, on the top and sides.
7. Allow CADC clay to thoroughly dry (48 hours)
9. Remove clay from aluminum foil-covered plate.
10. Attach ribbon to letter to display/hang.
