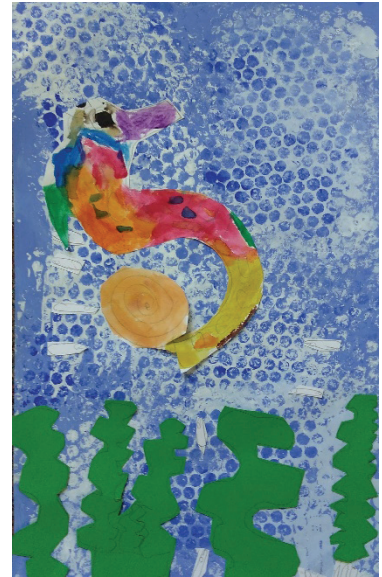


# Bubble Wrap Printmaking: Ocean Creatures

Materials: Bubble wrap, blue or white large paper, white and blue tempera or acrylic paint, paint brush, construction paper-assorted colors, scissors, pencil, glue, markers, crayons, or colored pencils



Directions:

1. Use your paint brush to paint the bubble wrap, bubble side up, with blue paint.
2. Place your bubble wrap paint side down onto your large paper.
3. Gently press on the back of your bubble wrap so that the paint presses into your paper.
4. Slowly peel the bubble wrap off of the paper starting from one corner.

Look at all those polka dots!

5. Repeat the process with white paint, right on top off your blue dots, while they are still wet.
6. Keep alternating with white and blue paint onto your bubble wrap, pressing and peeling, until your whole paper is filled.
7. Set your paper aside to dry.
8. Using construction paper make fish, seaweed, crabs, starfish, sharks, and seahorses to populate your ocean.
9. Cut out your sea creatures and glue them onto your bubble wrap printed ocean background.
