- Work that has previously hung at CCAA is not permitted unless staff makes exception.

- All artwork must be picked up on agreed upon date at end of the show unless arrangements are made.
- Artwork left behind becomes property of CCAA after 30 days from the show's end.
- All artwork must be 'exhibition ready.' See details below.
- An opening reception will be hosted by CCAA. Wine and a light snack will be served.

SALES & LIABILITY

- CCAA will retain a commission of 35% on all sales.
- Outside sales due to exposure at CCAA still require 35% commission. This only pertains to art sales that are a direct result of being seen at CCAA.
- CCAA assumes no responsibility for damage of artwork unrelated to our own handling.
- Entry to this show implies an agreement by the artist with all conditions set forth.

'Exhibition Ready' Details

2D Artwork

- All hanging artwork needs to be properly wired.
- Paintings should be framed or have clean/finished canvas edges without visible drips or unintentional marks.
- Works on paper, i.e. watercolor, pastel, pencil and hand-pulled prints, should be framed with protective glass to preserve them.
- Artwork with saw tooth hooks, ring hangs, plastic wire or yarn on the back is not acceptable. Unframed artwork on poster board or foam core is also not acceptable.

3D Artwork

- All 3D artwork needs to be stable and/or on a proper base.
- Artwork must be able to stand alone.
- For jewelry, please provide proper supports/stands to display the artwork if needed.
